**AMENDED ORDER TO DISMISS WITH PREJUDICE**


This cause coming to be heard on the motion of Tom Vaughn, Chapter 13 Trustee, to dismiss the instant bankruptcy for cause and with prejudice and to enjoin the Debtor from re-filing any bankruptcy matter permanently in any jurisdiction within the United States without prior court approval from the Chief Judge of this Court, and for the Debtor to be held in contempt for violation of several court Orders issued by this Court, and for the issuance of a body attachment to bring the Debtor before this court and held accountable for her contempt due notice having been given, the Court being fully advised in the premises, states:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. The above referenced case is dismissed pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1307 (c);
2. The Debtor is permanently prohibited from being a Debtor in any case under Title 11 in any jurisdiction within the United States without the expressed written permission of the Chief Judge of the Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Illinois;
3. The Debtor is held in contempt for her serial bankruptcy filings to wit, her violation of Chief Judge Black's January 5, 2016 Order barring her from filing for bankruptcy relief for five years in Case Number 15 B 42661.
4. Tierra Nicole Kirk is ordered to appear before this Court on April 11, 2016 at 219 South Dearborn Street, Chicago, Illinois, Courtroom 680 at 11:00 a.m. to show cause why she should not be held in contempt of court for failure to obey the January 5, 2016 court order. Failure to appear may result in an issuance of a warrant for her arrest.
