## ORDER DISMISSING CASE NO. 19bk29749 AND SETTING FURTHER TERMS OF BAR ON REFILING

This matter having come before the court on the Trustee's Motion to Dismiss for Failure to File Required Documents Under § 521(a)(1) [Case No. 19bk29749, Dkt. No. 12], the court having dismissed Case No. 19bk26955 on November 7, 2019 with a one-year bar on refiling [Case No. 19bk26955, Dkt. No. 18] (the "Bar Order"), the court having held a hearing in Case No. 19bk29749 on November 14, 2019 at which the Debtor appeared and for the reasons stated at such hearing,

## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Case No. 19bk29749 is dismissed.
- 2. The Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court will not accept a petition under any chapter of title 11 of the United State Code from the Debtor unless such petition is accompanied by an order of the court excepting such petition from the Bar Order.
- 3. Any request by the Debtor for an exception from the Bar Order shall be filed in Case No. 19bk26955 and will be ruled on by the court without holding a hearing.
- 4. Any such request for an exception from the Bar Order will not be granted unless such request attaches full and completed copies of following documents: the petition (Form 101); the summary of assets and liabilities (Form 106Sum); Schedules A/B, C, D, E/F, G, H, I and J (Forms 106A/B, 106C, 106D, 106E/F, 106G, 106H, 106I and 106J); the statement of financial affairs (Form 107); the chapter 13 plan (Form 113); the statement of social security number (Form 121); the statement of current monthly income and calculation of commitment period (Form 122C-1); the calculation of disposable income (Form 122C-2); the certificate of credit counseling; and copies of all payment

advices or other evidence of payment received by the Debtor from any employer within 60 days before the filing of such request.
