ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH PREJUDICE AND ADDITIONAL SANCTIONS

This matter coming to be heard on the Court's Order Granting Trustee's Motion for Civil Contempt and Ordering Debtor to Appear and Notice of Hearing (dkt. #29), that was duly served on the *pro se* debtor, Patricia A. Barker, and all other parties in interest (dkt. #31), with chapter 7 Trustee Cindy Johnson appearing and Ms. Barker being absent.

Upon consideration of whether Ms. Barker has purged the order of civil contempt for her repeated failure to comply with prior orders to turn over documents related to pre-petition bank withdrawals she made (dkt. #16) and if not, the appropriate sanction:

The Court finds and orders that:

1. Ms. Barker has already been held in civil contempt (dkt. #27), and that contempt has not been purged.
2. Following service of the Order and Notice of Hearing, Ms. Barker failed to appear and object to the proposed sanctions.
3. Accordingly, sanctions will be imposed as follows: all pre-petition debts as well as any amounts subsequently awarded as compensation pursuant to order of this court are deemed to be nondischargeable debts in this case and in any future bankruptcy filings by debtor Patricia A. Barker.
4. This Chapter 7 case shall be and is hereby dismissed, with prejudice, and debtor Patricia A. Barker is barred from refiling a case under any chapter of the United States Bankruptcy Code for a period of 180 days from the date of dismissal.
