**ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH A ONE-YEAR BAR TO REFILING ANY
BANKRUPTCY PROCEEDING**

The matter comes before the court on the chapter 13 trustee's Motion to Dismiss the Debtor's pending bankruptcy case for her failure to timely file a chapter 13 plan or schedules as required by 11 U.S.C. §§ 521(a) and 1321 and Fed. R. Bankr. P. 1007 and 3015(b). As this is the fourth chapter 13 petition filed by or on behalf of the Debtor with this court since 2017 in which the Debtor has failed to comply with her duties by timely filing a plan or schedules or otherwise prosecute her case after filing, the chapter 13 trustee seeks a one-year bar to refiling. The petition in this and each of the four cases are signed by an Emanuel Cretu, purporting to act under a power of attorney granted him by the Debtor Nicoleta Cretu. After due notice of the Motion to Dismiss, both the Debtor and Emanuel Cretu failed to respond or object.

Therefore, for the reasons stated in open court on January 4, 2024,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


1. The Motion to Dismiss is GRANTED, and the bankruptcy case is hereby DISMISSED.

2. Unless otherwise ordered on a proper motion for relief from this Order filed in this case:

- a. Debtor Nicoleta Cretu IS BARRED from directly or indirectly filing a bankruptcy petition or otherwise seeking relief under title 11 of the U.S. Code until January 4, 2025.
- b. Emanuel Cretu IS BARRED from filing a bankruptcy petition on his own behalf or on behalf of Nicoleta Cretu or otherwise seeking relief under title 11 of the U.S. Code until January 4, 2025.
