Brandon Adams has filed two frivolous petitions, Nos. 24-1227 & No. 24-2077, and was warned on August 2, 2024, that further frivolous emails or submissions could lead to sanctions including a filing bar. But he has not stopped: On August 12, 2024, Brandon Adams emailed the clerk of this court an "objection" to this court's order warning him about emailing the court without permission. Because Adams still does not have permission to file electronically or by email, that document will not be filed, and further emails will be deleted.

Adams has incurred \$1200 in filing fees for his frivolous petitions. Unless and until Adams pays these fees, the clerks of all federal courts in this circuit are directed to return any papers submitted either directly or indirectly by him or on his behalf. See In re: City of Chi., 500 F.3d 582, 585-86 (7th Cir. 2007); Support Sys. Int'l, Inc. v. Mack, 45 F.3d 185, 186 (7th Cir. 1995). In accordance with our decision in Mack, exceptions to this filing bar are made for criminal cases and for applications for writs of habeas corpus. See Mack, 45 F.3d at 186-87. This order will be lifted immediately once Adams makes full payment. See City of Chi., 500 F.3d at 585–86. If Adams, despite his best efforts, is unable to pay in full these fees, no earlier than two years from the date of this order he is authorized to submit to this court a motion to modify or rescind this order. See id.; Mack, 45 F.3d at 186.
