On October 14, 2020, this court sanctioned attorney Edward A. Williams \$2,500 for filing a frivolous appeal. The sanction was to be paid to the clerk of this court on or before October 28, 2020, but counsel has failed to pay the sanction.

Unless and until Williams pays his outstanding sanction, the clerks of all federal courts in this circuit are directed to return unfiled any papers submitted either directly or indirectly by him as attorney or on his own behalf. *See In re City of Chicago*, 500 F.3d 582, 585-86 (7th Cir. 2007); *In re Maurice*, 73 F.3d 124, 126–27 (7th Cir. 1995); *Support Sys. Int'l, Inc. v. Mack*, 45 F.3d 185, 186 (7th Cir. 1995). In accordance with our decision in *Mack*, exceptions to this filing bar are made for criminal cases and for applications for writs of habeas corpus on Williams's own behalf. *See Mack*, 45 F.3d at 186-87. This order will be lifted immediately once Williams makes full payment. *See City of Chicago*, 500 F.3d at 585-86. If Williams, despite his best efforts, is unable to pay in full the outstanding sanction, no earlier than two years from the date of this order he is authorized to submit to this court a motion to modify or rescind this order. *See id.*; *Mack*, 45 F.3d at 186.
