Bar Order

On Monday January 7, 2019 the Debtor appeared in court where she faced several Motions to Dismiss in Bankruptcy Case 18-29038. She claimed to have filed all required documents. However, with respect to the Motion to Dismiss for failure to make plan payments she alleged that she had the funds, not that she had sent in funds to pay plan payments then due. Bankruptcy Case 18-29038 was dismissed on that date.

Before the dismissal order was entered the Debtor filed this case, 19-00350, on January 7, 2019. This case is her ninth bankruptcy petition.

She filed an emergency motion in this 19-00350 case asking to impose an automatic stay. This Court denied leave to file that emergency motion because the Debtor's refusal to make plan payments (earlier that day) was not reasonable for a repeat filer.

The Debtor filed for bankruptcy relief under chapter 7 on June 21, 2005. That case, 05-24527, was dismissed on January 5, 2006 for failure to pay the filing fee.

The Debtor filed for bankruptcy relief under chapter 7 on July 13, 2011. That case, 11-28784, was closed without a discharge on February 6, 2012. A Motion to Reopen and a Motion to Waive Fee were each denied on May 16, 2012.

The Debtor filed for bankruptcy relief under chapter 7 on January 23, 2013. That case, 13-02504, was dismissed for failure to file documents on March 5, 2013.

Seven days later, the Debtor filed for bankruptcy relief under chapter 7 on March 12, 2013. That case, 13-9718, was dismissed for failure to pay filing fee on June 25, 2013.

Two days later, the debtor filed for bankruptcy relief under chapter 7 on June 27, 2013. That case, 13-26262, was dismissed for failure to pay filing fee on December 17, 2013.

Three days later, the debtor filed for bankruptcy relief under chapter 7 on December 20,

2013. The Debtor received a discharge in that case, 13-48631, on May 2, 2014.

The Debtor filed for bankruptcy relief under chapter 13 on August 15, 2018. That case, 18-23009, was dismissed for failure to file a plan on October 15, 2018.

The next day, on October 16, 2018 the Debtor filed for bankruptcy relief under chapter 13. That case, 18-29038, was dismissed on January 7, 2019 for failure to make plan payments; the Debtor stated in court that she had funds, but had not sent the funds to the Trustee. The automatic stay had been extended to January 7, 2019; that motion was denied on January 7, 2019 at Docket 31.

That brings us to this 19-00350 case, filed on the same date that case 18-29038 was dismissed.

The Motion to Impose an Automatic Stay is denied. The Debtor has not filed a Certificate of Service showing that this Motion has been served on all creditors, as well as the U.S. Trustee and the Chapter 13 Trustee.

The court finds that due to the Debtor's many filings she has little disregard for bankruptcy requirements. The Debtor has not shown that bankruptcy case 19-00350 was filed in good faith. *See* 11 U.S.C. § 362(c)(4)(A)(i).


On March 4, 2019 the court faced a Motion to Dismiss for Failure to Make Plan Payments. The Debtor did not appear. It was reported that the Debtor has not made any Plan payments to date in this latest case, 18-00350. This case was dismissed for failure to make plan payments by separate order.

In addition, the Debtor has not paid the filing fee although the first installment of that fee was due on or before February 6, 2019.

Due to Debtor's bad faith filing herein, as well as her many other deficient bankruptcy filings, she is barred from filing for relief under any chapter of the Bankruptcy Code for one year, on or before March 4, 2020.
